
TRASH SERVICES

- Trash will be collected twice a week
- Farmers Branch trash collection days are Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday
- Place all items at your front curb by 7 a.m. for service between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Household trash should be set out in disposable bags or boxes
- Place bagged leaves by curb on designated trash day



RECYCLING SERVICES

Handles Out



- Recyclables will be collected once a week
- For efficient driver retrieval, place blue cart with handles toward the street by 7 a.m.
- On service days, carts should not be placed in the street. They should be placed behind curb line or alleyway, away from fences and shrubs
- Separate recyclables and trash by 10 ft.
- Carts storage and retrieval must comply with City ordinance
- Place 95-gallon cart 3 ft. away from any obstacles: such as mailboxes, cars, gas meters or drainage ditches
- See the map to the right for designated service day
