The City of Farmers Branch is conducting a watershed study for Farmers Branch Creek. The study is intended to identify erosion and flooding concerns relative to the creek. Residents were notified in September 2016 of the study. The initial findings of the Farmers Branch Creek Storm Watershed Study conducted by Freese and Nichols, Inc. are ready to be presented to the public. This presentation will identify existing erosion and flooding conditions along the creek and present possible conceptual alternatives for these conditions.
