Welcome to the Farmers Branch Teen Camp!

Welcome to the Farmers Branch Teen Leadership Program (Teen Camp). We're glad you're here. You'll get experience volunteering with The Farmers Branch Animal Adoption Center, Parks Division, Historical Park, and The Branch Connection. We are partnering with Be Project this year on Tuesday afternoons. Be Project requires a signed waiver by parent/guardian.

Teen Camp Handbook

You should have received the Teen Camp Handbook. In the back of the Handbook is a form for you and your parent to sign and return within 48 hours of your first day in the program. If you have not returned the form, please do so ASAP. If you need another copy of the Handbook, just ask Adriana.

What to Wear

You should dress comfortably. Shorts and t-shirts are best. Bare midriff shirts, tight clothing, short-shorts, and cut-offs are not allowed. Clothing should not have any pictures or sayings that are inappropriate. Athletic shoes are recommended. Flip flops and any other open-toe shoes are not allowed. For details about what you can and can't wear, refer to your Handbook. Just remember, you're going to be outside a lot and this isn't a fashion show, so just take a cue from the Teen Camp Leaders and dress like they do.

When You Get Here

Between the hours of 7:30 AM-9 AM all teens should report to the Magnolia Room (Teen Room). If you arrive after 9 AM, you need to check with a staff member to see where your group is. Be sure to check in with Adriana when you get here. You're not "officially" here until you've checked in with a leader.

When You Leave

When you leave, you must be signed out by an adult or have written permission to sign yourself out no earlier than 4 PM. If you bring a note that says you are allowed to sign out, it needs to state what time you are allowed to sign out. Your parent also needs to sign and date the note and include his/her driver's license number. If you sign out before 6 PM and plan to hang around the Recreation Center, you must have a membership. Once you're signed out, you cannot hang out with the Teen Camp.

End of Summer Lock-In

The free "end of summer" lock-in is set for 8 PM Friday, August 9 until 7 AM, Saturday, August 10. Activities include a pizza party, movies, games in the Magnolia Room, games in the gym, and other activities. The lock-in is by invitation only for those who have completed approximately 80 hours of community service in the Teen Camp program (this includes service with the Animal Shelter, Parks projects, Historical Park, Senior Center, and other Community Service projects performed during the Teen Camp program) and have remained in good standing. Those who qualify will receive an invitation by August 5. Participants must RSVP by August 6 in order to attend. Participants who have not received enough hours to attend will be notified.

Friday Activities

You'll get to go on a trip, or watch movies, and hang out with your friends in the Teen Camp. You'll likely need to bring some cash for the trip, so check with Adriana for details about field trip information. There may be a few Fridays when Summer Funshine has a field trip planned so the bus won't be available for the Teen Camp. We'll have a special activity in those situations.

Free Breakfast and Lunch

The Summer Food Service Program at Blair Elementary runs Monday, June 3 - Friday, July 26 (except July 4th). Breakfast is served from 8AM-9AM and lunch is served from 11:30AM - 1PM You can get a copy of the menu at the Summer Funshine sign out desk or online at fbrecenter.com

Next Week

If you plan to be here each week, please make sure a parent has registered you. If you are not yet registered and want to attend, make sure you register no later than the Friday prior to the next week! The cost is \$15/week for residents.

Non-residents may register on a weekly basis depending upon availability. Registration will open Thursday for the upcoming week if space is available. The cost is \$40/week for non-residents.

Lost and Found

Please do not bring valuables or large sums of money to the program. Staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lost and Found items will be taken to Metrocrest Social Services on a regular basis.
