Victorian murder and mayhem on tap Oct 29 and 30 at Farmers Branch Historical Park

FARMERS BRANCH | Wednesday, October 28, 2015 ~ Famous and infamous Victorian-era murders and mayhem, inspired by the works of Edgar Allan Poe and real historical events, will be presented in entertaining fashion at the Farmers Branch Historical Park Halloween week, October 29 and 30.

Tours will be held from 5 until 7:30 p.m. each day. Admission is free.

The Historical Park's Danielle Brissette said the tours will highlight some of the more interesting and haunting stories of the Victorian era. Those attending will learn about the "Servant Girl Annihilator," a serial killer who stalked Austin in 1885, spot the "murder weapon" in the Victorian kitchen and explore the perils of Victorian clothing.

Tours are presented in partnership with the Dallas Public Library. Themes are intended for a mature audience so no one under 16 will be admitted.
