Caring for your Family this Summer

Welcome to Summer Funshine 2020. This summer will be different than previous summers, but we're making the most of this new adventure. This is the weekly calendars that will serve as an outline for each week. This calendar doesn't list details, only highlights for each week. Where you see 'Age Group Fun', that means your child's group is participating in age-appropriate activities such as games, arts, and crafts, reading time, and more.

We've made some changes to our operations this year. Your grace and patience as we adapt and adjust is greatly appreciated. Details are outlined in the *Parent Guide Addendum & FAQ* document. The document can be viewed on our website at www.fbreccenter.com. You may request a hard copy from the Leaders during sign out or a digital version by contacting the Recreation Center Manager or Recreation Programs Coordinator (contact information listed below). The original *Parent Guide and Standards of Care* can also be viewed and/or obtained in the same manner.

Lots of Changes. Here are the Highlights.

Below is a list of some of the major changes. This is not a comprehensive list. Details are outlined in the *Parent Guide Addendum and FAQ*.

- Program meets at The Branch Connection.
- All participants must wear a mask indoors.
- Your child should eat breakfast before arriving each day and bring a lunch Monday-Thursday. We will provide lunch on Fridays. See a staff member for information on "Fun Food Fridays". The traditional "free breakfast and lunch" program we normally participate in will not take place this summer. C-FBISD offers Grab and Go meals for C-FBISD families to pick up weekly in June and July. Staff will not be able to pick up meals for families. If you are not utilizing the Grab and Go meal service, please send your child with a sack lunch.
- No field trips are scheduled at this time. Trips to local parks may be scheduled later this summer.
- Parents/guardians and visitors are not permitted inside the building.
- We are still swimming this summer. Read the Swimming section for details.
- COVID-19 symptom screenings and temperature checks will be performed on each participant and staff member every day upon arrival.

Afternoon Snacks

As always, we'll provide an afternoon snack. Your child may bring a snack from home if he/she prefers. Your child does not need to bring money to purchase snacks as we will not be visiting vending machines or concession stands. Ice Cream snack is provided on Wednesdays.

Our Administering Medications Policy

If your child requires medication during program hours, the medication must be in the original container. A Medicine Form must also be completed by the parent in order for staff to administer medication. Medicine Forms are available via email from the Recreation Center Manager or Recreation Programs Coordinator. Participants may not store or administer their own medications. Medications requiring refrigeration must be noted on the medicine form. Inhalers and peak flows must have instruc-

tions. There are additional requirements for administering EpiPens. Please read the Standards of Care (updated in 2017) section in the *Parent Guide* located at the Sign-out counter and online at fbrec-center.com.

Swimming

All groups swim one day per week during non-public swim hours. That means each group gets the entire waterpark exclusively during swim time. Participants under seven years and participants of any age who choose not to take the swim test, or those who take and do not pass take the swim test, are required to wear a red wristband and stay within arms reach of a staff member. We understand that being within arms reach doesn't allow for social distancing, but it is safer to keep less-experienced swimmers close by. At the discretion of Aquatics Center Staff, lifejackets may be required for those who do not pass the swim test. Lifejackets are provided. If you wish to provide your own lifejacket, it must be a Coast Guard Approved Personal Floation Device. In addition to the regular weekly swim time, each group will get one bonus Friday swim day from 10-11:30 am. Bonus Friday Swim Days are:

June 26– Guppies (1st graders)

July 17– Joeys (2nd and 3rd graders)

July 31– Llamas (4th and 5th graders)

August 14– Super Sloths (6/7th graders)

Children should bring a labeled towel and swimsuit, and sunscreen on swim days. Your child will need to be able to apply his/her own sunscreen. Participants may not share supplies.

Swim Lessons

Fee-based swim lesson classes will not be offered. Participants who are identified as non-swimmers will participate in the Beginner Swim Lesson which will take place during swim time for the younger and middle 1 groups. Aquatics staff will identify those who are in need of swim lessons. If your child is a non-swimmer between the ages of 6-8 years and you'd like him/her to participate in swim lessons, please inform your child's Leader.

Payment, Late Fees, & Financial Aid Info

Please pay attention to the payment schedule and payment reminders. Payments are drafted June 19, July 10 and July 24. Each draft is \$209/child for residents, \$110/child for residents receiving financial assistance, and \$330/child for non-residents. Because the program is starting two weeks later than originally scheduled, all fees and/or accounts have been adjusted accordingly. Rejected payments will incur a late penalty fee of \$5 if not paid by 9 am the following business day. Families with extenuating circumstances should reach out to the Recreation Center Manager prior to payment draft dates. Non-payment within five-business days may result in dismissal from the program. Refer to the *Parent Guide* for details.

Drop Off, Pick Up, and Program Hours

Program hours at 7:30 am-6 pm. Please drop off your child at the main entrance of The Branch Connection between the hours of 7:30 am-9 am. Please do NOT drop off earlier than 7:30 am as the building is not open and there is no supervision prior to 7:30 am. Pick up is from 4:30-6 pm. If you plan to arrive after 9 am or pick up before 4:30 pm, please contact The Branch Connection at 972.919.8740 upon your arrival so that a staff member may make arrangements for your child to enter/

exit the facility. In order to limit interactions, The facility is secured during program hours. Parents/guardians and guests are not permitted in the building. Please refer to the *Parent Guide Addendum and FAQ* for details.

What NOT to Bring

Participants should refrain from bringing toys, large sums of money, and other valuables during the program. If your child brings a phone or tablet, it may only be used during designated times and may not be shared with other participants. The City of Farmers Branch is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Lost and Found

All personal items such as backpacks, towels, lunches, sunscreen, etc. should be labeled. If your child is missing any items, please inform the Recreation Center Manager or Recreation Programs Coordinator about the missing item(s) within five-business days. A staff member will check the Lost and Found area and follow up with you. Unclaimed Lost and Found items are donated weekly.

Who Can Sign Out Your Child?

If you are unsure about who you have listed on your Summer Funshine packet, please contact the Recreation Center Manager or Recreation Programs Coordinator Center (contact information listed below). Staff will require proof of identification before providing this information. If you need to add someone to the list of authorized persons, email a note with your child's name, grade, authorized person's name and driver's license number, and your signature and driver's license number to the Recreation Center Manager (contact information listed below). Refer to the Sign-Out Policy in the *Parent Guide* for details. Staff will request to see your government-issued ID, so please bring it with you during sign-out each day. We look forward to a safe and fun summer!
