

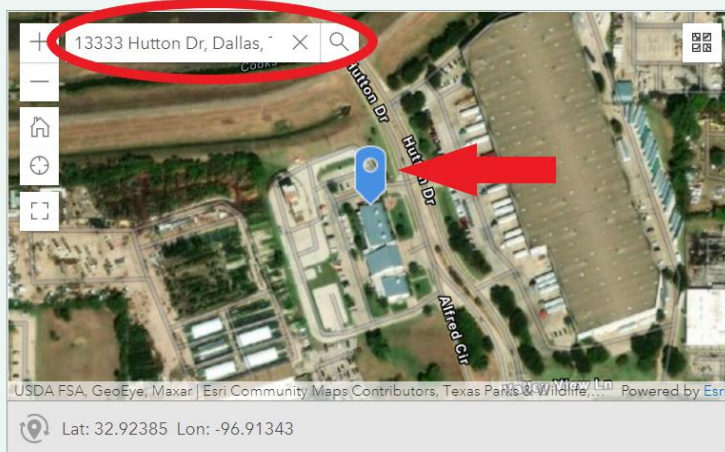
Additional Instructions for TDEM:

- **Select the radio button** indicating if you are reporting for a **business or personal** property.
- Complete your **personal contact information**
- On the map, **enter the address of the damage** you are reporting. You will see blue marker pop up which you can use to move to the exact location.

Impacted Location Information:

*Click Map to Move Pin to Indicate the Exact Impacted Location:

Accurately reporting the location of the damaged structure will allow emergency management to prioritize recovery efforts in the most affected areas. Use the Search Bar or Find My Location Button along the left side of the map to help locate the proper address.



Confirm the impacted property's location on the map. You can Zoom In and Click on the map to line-up the pin on the impacted building, use the Address Search Bar across the top, or select the Find My Location Button along the left side of the map to help locate the property.

- Enter **street address and city** if it does not automatically populate.

Please provide photos to help the emergency managers understand the full scope of any impacts in your area. These photos help let agencies and volunteer organizations know where and how to send assistance. While not all photos are required, the more you are able to provide, the better understanding you will give of your area's impacts. Only return to the property to take photos if it is safe and legal to do so.

Interior Photos

In the case of flooding, interior photos are helpful to indicated water depth inside the home. Please stand a few feet away from the interior walls while taking pictures of water line marks so emergency managers can gain a sense of the water depth from it's surroundings.

Exterior Photos

If relevant, walk around the outside of the Main Building and document any damage with photographs. Please take photos of an entire side of building at eye-level and directly facing the exterior wall or of damaged roof areas.
